RULES AND GUIDLINES

- The Commando Course, Low Ropes Course, Zip Line, Bush Walks and Mangrove Forest are out of bounds unless accompanied by a responsible adult or an authorised facilitator.
- All vehicles are to be parked in the designated parking area. No vehicles may be driven onto or parked on any of the camp fields.
- The Mangrove Forest is one of the most threatened ecosystems in the world and is therefore a highly protected area. Special care must be taken to ensure that no plants or creatures are damaged in any way.
- There are many wild animals and creatures that live in and around our property. Please do not tease them or feed them as they can be dangerous.
- Please do not damage or cut any plants or trees on the premises. Should you need wood for a bonfire or other reasonable natural resources for an activity, we are happy to assist you on request.
- We request that all vehicles be park in the designated parking area.
- No loud noise (shouting, screaming, music, drums) is allowed from 10 pm to 7 am.
- To prevent accidents, only cooks and kitchen assistants are allowed in the kitchen and all gas shut off valves must be closed after every use to prevent gas from leaking.
- There is to be no ironing inside the hall, bedrooms and/or bungalows.
- There are bins provided in every toilet and bathroom and we kindly request that anything other than toilet paper be placed in these bins to prevent blockages in our waste system.
- Please notify management of any breakages that occur during your stay.
- Please pay attention to warning signs. They are there to ensure your safety.
