Catering:

We source our ingredients fresh and so some options may not always be available. Tea and coffee will be available throughout the day and juice will be served with every meal.

When planning your camp, you can give us suggestions of preferred dishes and we will put a menu together for your camp depending on availability and cost of ingredients.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To avoid disappointment, check the rules of campsite before booking.

Camping is fun, but to make sure that everyone has a great time, campers need to respect and abide by the campsite rules. If you have specific requirements that don't align with our rules, we suggest you look for an alternative campsite that will suit you. Fines will be imposed and campers may be asked to leave if camp rules are broken. Good camping etiquette ensures that everyone will enjoy the experience.

Arrivals and Departures

Arrival time is from **15:00 onwards on the day of arrival** unless otherwise arranged. A camp leader (or a delegate, by arrangement) must be available to accept the keys and responsibility of the camp site and kitchen hand-over before 17:00, unless prior arrangements have been made.

Please note: If campers arrive before 14:30 on the day of arrival, they will be charged an extra days' rate.

Departure time is BEFORE 14:00. on the day of departure. Please ensure you have vacated your rooms by 10:00 to enable our team to prepare for the next groups arrival.

A camp leader (or a delegate, by arrangement) must be available to hand back the responsibility of the camp site with all the keys and kitchen inventory prior to departure. All campsite facilities should be left in the same condition as you found them. This applies to the grounds, bedrooms, bungalows, washing up areas for dishes, bathrooms, toilets, showers and the kitchen.

All bedding must be placed back on the beds in the hall.

All tablecloths must be placed back on tables.

The kitchen must be kept clean at all times and left clean and neat on departure. Items in the kitchen need to be placed where they were found. Please check the Kitchen Inventory. All litter must be picked up (anywhere on the grounds).

Please report breakages and faulty equipment to management.

Please note: If campers leave after 14:00 on the day of departure they will be charged an extra days' rate.

Pets

Please be advised that no pets are allowed.

Eating utensils

Please remind your campers to bring their own eating utensils as these are not provided for campers. Campers are responsible for washing their own eating utensils.

Electronic Equipment.

Any electronic equipment, extension plugs, multiplugs etc. will be hired out at R 100,00.



Sports Equipment.

Campers need to supply their own sports equipment.

First Aid

Please be advised that first aid on site is the responsibility of the group organizer. There is no first aid equipment provided by Camp Anerley and you are required to bring your own first aid equipment/supplies with you to be used by your group during your stay. Camp management will also need to be advised as to who your dedicated First Aid officer is.

Emergency numbers will be posted in various places on site and a list of these numbers will be given to you on arrival.

Kitchen access

The kitchen is an out of bounds area during catered camps. No unauthorized person may enter or make use of the kitchen and/or the kitchen equipment.

Meal times

Meals are served as follows: Breakfast is at 8am, Lunch is at 12:30pm and Supper is at 6pm. Please ensure campers arrive to meals on time. Times can be altered to accommodate your programme, by arrangement.

Fines

You will be fined a spot fine of **R250.00** if you are found damaging any fauna, flora, buildings and equipment on site.

A fine of **R1 000.00** will be imposed for blockages due to flushing feminine products or other foreign matter down the toilet instead of using the bins provided.

You will be charged for any damages, breakages, etc. that may have occurred during your stay. Once the camp has been inspected and Camp Management has established the cost of the repairs, replacements, etc. an invoice will be sent to you which will be payable immediately.

Any person visiting or using the Camp Anerley premises or facilities does so at their own risk. Camp Anerley Campsite, Camp Anerley Management and Staff Members will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, injury or death to any person or their property whether caused by fire, theft or any other cause whatsoever.

Submission of the booking form together with the payment of the R7500 booking deposit will serve as your acceptance of the rates, terms and conditions laid out in this document.
