WHAT WE OFFER:

1. Accommodation:

Total 120 beds

Hall accommodation:

6 rooms with 2 single beds each. These rooms feature spacious cupboards for convenient storage. Comfortable mattresses and crisp clean sheets are provided. Separate ablution block with showers and a family bathroom.

Dorm accommodation:

8 dormitory style rooms with 6 double bunk beds. Each dorm sleeps 12 people. Bunk beds are equipped with mattresses, please bring your own linen. Ablution blocks with showers.



2. Simple delicious meals:

We will send you four menu options to choose from. If you would prefer to build your own menu, you may do so at an additional cost.

We source our ingredients fresh and so some options may not always be available.

3. Tailor made programme:

Activities based on your needs as a camp, whether it be spiritual, team-building, adventure or leadership focused. Activities are run by well trained, seasoned facilitators.

Dietary requirements and allergens will also be requested from you 14 days before the arrival of your group. We will prepare special meals for those who have dietary requirements or allergies. We do also cater for Halaal campers, however we are not Halaal certified.

Wake-up and lights-out times will vary depending on the age group of the campers. You are welcome to give suggestions on these times based on your group dynamic.

Full Package 2025 Rates

Rates are dependent on a number of factors. We have three options available:

- Weekend Camp: This option runs from Friday 6pm until Sunday 2pm
- Mid-week Camp: This option runs from 9am on the arrival day until 2pm on the departure day. Mid-week camps can be run from Monday-Thursday.
- Day Camp: This option is for those who wish not to stay over. This option runs from 9am until 3pm- any day of the week (subject to availability).

If you wish to structure your camp slightly differently, you are welcome to make contact with us and we will personalize your quote in order to suit your specific requirements.

Complete package fee for the above options are as follows:

Please be advised that your camp booking is only secure once you have returned the completed Booking Form along with a booking **deposit of R7500** which will be credited towards your total camp fee.



Terms and Conditions

To avoid disappointment, check the rules of campsite before booking.

Camping is fun, but to make sure that everyone has a great time, campers need to respect and abide by the campsite rules. If you have specific requirements that don't align with our rules, we suggest you look for an alternative campsite that will suit you. Fines will be imposed and campers may be asked to leave if camp rules are broken. Good camping etiquette ensures that everyone will enjoy the experience.

Arrivals and Departures

Arrival time is from **15:00 onwards on the day of arrival** unless otherwise arranged or during the week.

Please note: If campers arrive before 14:30 on the day of arrival, they will be charged an extra days' rate.

Departure time is BEFORE 14:00. on the day of departure. Please ensure you have vacated your rooms by 10:00 to enable our team to prepare for the next groups arrival.

All campsite facilities should be left in the same condition as you found them. This applies to the grounds, bedrooms, bungalows, washing up areas for dishes, bathrooms, toilets, showers and the kitchen.

All bedding must be placed back on the beds in the hall.

All tablecloths must be placed back on tables.

The kitchen must be kept clean at all times and left clean and neat on departure (if self-catering).

All litter must be picked up (anywhere on the grounds).

Please report breakages and faulty equipment to management.

Please note: If campers leave after 14:00 on the day of departure they will be charged an extra days' rate.

Pets

Please be advised that no pets are allowed.

Eating utensils

Please remind your campers to bring their own eating utensils as these are not provided for campers. Campers are responsible for washing their own eating utensils.

Electronic Equipment.

Any electronic equipment, extension plugs, multiplugs etc. will be hired out at R 100,00 per item.



Sports Equipment.

All equipment needed for programme will be supplied by Camp Anerley. If a group would like to run their own activities when facilitators are off site, the group will need to supply their own equipment. No Camp programme equipment may be used while Camp Anerley management are off site.

First Aid

Please be advised that first aid on site is the responsibility of the group organizer. You are required to bring your own first aid equipment/supplies with you to be used by your group during your stay. Camp management will also need to be advised as to who your dedicated First Aid officer is.

Emergency numbers have been posted in various places on site.

Indemnity

No campers will be allowed to participate in facilitated camp activities without having given management a signed indemnity form. If the camper is younger than 18 years, the indemnity form will need to be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Kitchen access

The kitchen is an out of bounds area during catered camps. No unauthorized person may enter or make use of the kitchen and/or the kitchen equipment.

Meal times

Meals are served as follows: Breakfast is at 8am, Lunch is at 12:30pm and Supper is at 6pm. Please ensure campers arrive to meals on time. Times can be altered to accommodate your programme, by arrangement.

Fines

You will be fined a spot fine of **R250.00** if you are found damaging any fauna, flora, buildings and equipment on site.

A fine of **R1 000.00** will be imposed for blockages due to flushing feminine products or other foreign matter down the toilet instead of using the bins provided.

You will be charged for any damages, breakages, etc. that may have occurred during your stay. Once the camp has been inspected and Camp Management has established the cost of the repairs, replacements, etc. an invoice will be sent to you which will be payable immediately.

Any person visiting or using the Camp Anerley premises or facilities does so at their own risk. Camp Anerley Campsite, Camp Anerley Management and Staff Members will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, injury or death to any person or their property whether caused by fire, theft or any other cause whatsoever.

Submission of the booking form together with the payment of the R7500 booking deposit will serve as your acceptance of the rates, terms and conditions laid out in this document.
